OSHA pages:

<http://www.osha.gov/> This is the home page for OSHA.

1. Under **Compliance Assistance**, go to **Quick Start** and scroll to **Construction Industry**
2. Scroll down on the right to get to the Cal/Osha page by selecting **State Programs**.
3. On the left side of the page, under About OSHA, choose the mission statement and OSHA facts.
4. Also on the left, go to publications, and find Industry Topics. There is a drop-down list to choose from.

Using EBSCOhost:

Put the keyword **OSHA** in the search box. Also try **OSHA penalties, OSHA regulations**, etc.

Go in by subject by selecting the tab at the top of the page, and put in **concrete** or **flooring, concrete**.

Browse articles in ENR: Engineering News-Record by choosing the **Publications** tab at the top of the page and entering **ENR** in the search box. That will bring up a list of ENR by year.
